Radio

All 10 Yale Football games can be heard live on News/Talk 960 WELI-AM and free over the internet at 960WELI.com. Ron Vaccaro '04 (play-by-play) and Carm Cozza (color) will have the call.

Cozza, the all-time winningest coach in the Ivy League and a member of the College Football Hall of Fame, begins his 13th season in the radio booth after a 32-year head coaching tenure during which he led the Bulldogs to 10 Ivy League championships. The new locker room at Smilow Field Center was named in his honor this season.

Vaccaro enters his fifth full season as the Voice of the Bulldogs and has been covering the team since 2000 when he entered Yale as a freshman. He has won two Emmy Awards for his work with NBC Sports and Olympics, his primary employer since graduating from Yale with distinction in political science in May 2004. He called race walking and modern pentathlon for NBC at the 2008 Beijing Olympics and the 2009 World Swimming Championships for Universal Sports. He has covered a total of four Olympics for NBC. This fall marks his fifth season as the Research Supervisor on the network's Football Night in America show.

Producer/engineer Tom Ivanovich, who has also been a member of the broadcast team since 1998 and spotter/statistician Kevin Guarino add the finishing touches to the coverage.

All six home games this season will be video streamed live (pay per view) on yalebulldogs.com through Yale's All Access with Vaccaro and Cozza providing the call.

Broadcasts of Yale football, along with several other sports during the year, are available on the Yale student station, WYBC 1340 AM (wybc.com).

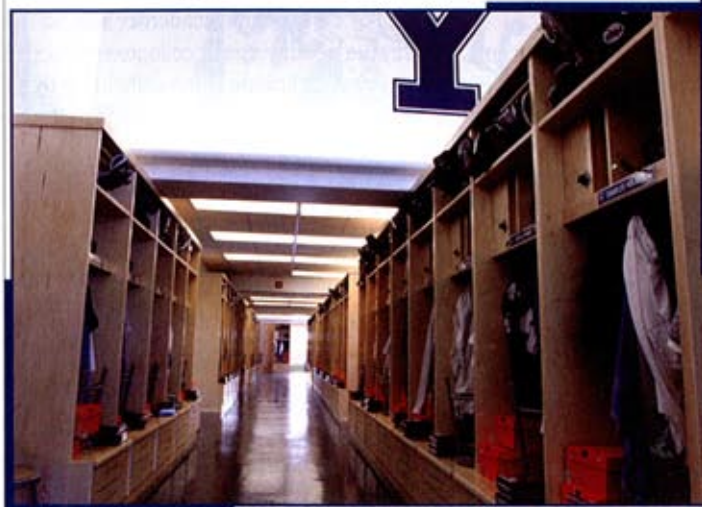
Tuesdays at Mory's
